2. Scientific & Creative Chart Projects

Project Work: Hands-on Learning & Observation

- **Social Studies (Model of the Earth Project):**
Build or construct a 3D model of the Earth (such as a decorated globe) or design a neat circular diagram on cardboard. Show and label the major imaginary lines clearly, including the Equator, Tropic of Cancer, Tropic of Capricorn, and the Prime Meridian.
- **Science (Living vs. Non-Living Things Showcase):**
On a white chart paper, draw or paste pictures representing **5 Living Things** and **5 Non-Living Things**. Write down their respective names and mention two main differences between them.
- **Computer Science (Types of Computers Chart):**
Collect and paste high-quality pictures representing different types of computers (e.g., Micro-computers/Desktops, Laptops, Tablets, Mainframes, and Supercomputers) on a chart paper. Write their names and primary uses underneath.
- **General Knowledge (Popular Personalities of India):**
Collect and paste photographs of **10 popular/inspiring individuals of India** on a chart paper. For each personality, write their full name and their respective field of work (e.g., Science, Sports, Literature, Politics, or Social Service).

Activity Guidelines: Creative Expression & Design

Activity 1 : Importance of Water in Summer (गर्मी में पानी का महत्व)

On a decorated chart paper, explain the critical importance of water conservation during the dry summer season. Highlight the major problems caused by water shortage and global droughts through hand-drawn pictures, diagrams, or pasted illustrations.
